



Site options turn features on or off for the site and allow you to customize how they work. Make a site public or private, add embed code to track site performance, add quick facts to catalog headers, manage social sharing options and change site vocabulary terms

## Site Options Overview



### Site Access

Make a portal public or private and turn on the login link in the header. Set if the individual lands on the home page or dashboard after login. Add a message to appear on the login screen for private sites.



### Embed Code

Copy and paste embed code from 3<sup>rd</sup> party sites to allow you to use technology from companies like Google to track site performance.



### Quick Facts

Add quick facts to a catalog's home page header, to a catalog administrator's dashboard, or to a site administrator's dashboard. Quick Facts come from fields in the catalog administration database.



### Social Sharing

Turn social sharing on for the portal and select the social media sites. Links to these sites will appear for viewers to share posts on social media.



### Vocabulary

Change the words used to describe site wide features such as posts, catalogs or members.
